STANDING REGULATIONS – REG.

No. 059 / 10550

Implementation of the Karnataka Transparency
In Public Procurements Act, 1999 & Rules
Made thereunder

Dt: 20.11.2001.

1. GOK has promulgated the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Act 1999 which has come into effect from the 4th day of October 2000.
2. The purpose of the Act is to provide for ensuring transparency in public procurement of goods and services by streamlining the procedures in inviting, processing and acceptance of tenders.
3. As per the Act, KPCL shall not procure goods/services except without inviting tenders. The Act is applicable where the value of goods and services to be procured exceeds Rs. 5.00 lakhs.
4. The State Tender Bulletin Officer for the purpose of KPCL is the Deputy Secretary, Energy Department, Bangalore and the District Tender Bulletin Officer is the Deputy Commissioner of the respective district.
5. `TIA` is an officer appointed to invite tenders and `TAA` is an officer appointed to accept tenders.
6. In accordance with section 9 of the Act, the following shall be the Tender Inviting Authorities [TIA] and Tender Accepting Authorities [TAA]:

7. The duties of Tender Inviting Authorities [TIA] are:

- a) To take out the notice inviting tenders [NIT] on the instruction from the accepting authorities.
- b) To communicate NIT to the Tender Bulletin Officer [as detailed in para 4 above]

- c) To cause publication of the notice inviting tender in the prescribed manner
- d) To supply schedule of rates and Tender document to every intending tenderer(s), who has applied to get such document.

The TIA`s shall collect all the details received in response to the notice inviting tender within the time stipulated and unless it is itself authorized to open shall compile and forward the tender to the authority or officer authorized to open the same.

8. The Tender Accepting Authorities shall

- a) pass an order accepting the tender;
- b) communicate the information relating to acceptance of tender together with comparative statement and reason for accepting tenders to the Tender Bulletin Officer and KPCL [RO]

9. The Contract Management Group [CMG] which is a multidisciplinary mechanism shall act as a single window clearance to facilitate the Tender Accepting Authority [TAA] to accept tenders within its delegation of power.

10. All the TIA`s and TAA`s shall be responsible to comply with the requirements indicated in the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Act 1999 and rules made thereunder. A brief summary of the Act and the Rules are enclosed for ready reference.
